RESULT AND DISCUSSION

Millennial Generation

Millennials are Multitaskers interpreted as a condition where the younger generation feels accustomed to carrying out more than one job at the same time, for example, in doing two tasks at once while listening to songs from a smartphone with a mouth engrossed in chewing snacks. The last characteristic is Millennials are Techno-Savvy which is defined as a condition of very rapid technological development that often causes culture shock for previous generations. So that efforts to implement character education learning can be relied upon through teachers or lecturers who teach and help from parents and awareness of the child himself.[5]

The teacher here serves as the party who provides the material, while the students will practice it through quasi-judicial practice. After completing the presentation and practice of the material, it will be followed by a written test session to test how deep the students' understanding of the material provided by using the Role Playing Technique is. After being carried out for approximately 2 days of research practice, several conclusions were found, namely on the first day each student still did not show signs of increasing learning motivation and activity in the classroom, but on the second day where all learning activities were carried out and fully held by the students. Students with practical learning, of course, found a significant difference. The difference is that students tend to be more active in the activities of the learning process. The students also tend to understand more about the course of the material through the Role Playing Technique compared to having to listen to lectures or presentations from the teacher on duty. In addition, students' interest in this matter tends to be higher due to curiosity about the related material. Although it has quite a positive impact on the continuity of student activity and understanding in the classroom, this learning activity tends to take a long time. In addition, this type of learning technique cannot be applied to all subjects (2).

However, if we conclude this learning technique, if it is tested into the learning technique of character education and Pancasila, it might be successful. Why? Because the learning of character education and Pancasila is

related to the moral education of the nation's young generation, of course the impact will be directly visible, namely in the form of real practice. Materials such as any values in Pancasila that can shape an individual's personality towards a better direction are mere theories.
