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ABSTRACT

As the basis of the state whose substance has been considered absolute and has become a way of life for the Indonesian people, Pancasila has encountered various challenges in its practice. The millennial generation's biggest challenge with their technological skills is influenced easily by things they do not understand. This article discusses how important the existence of Pancasila protect the nation's next generation, or as we knew, the millennials, from the negative impacts of these technological advances and efforts to overcome them. This generation is a group of people burdened with bringing Indonesia forward with the knowledge they have. The development of technology has resulted in the existence and practice of values in Pancasila starting to fade. The millennial generation has no doubt become a generation that lives under the auspices of technology, and they cannot separate from their devices even for a second. technology. There are many advances in transportation, telecommunication tools, and even education, mainly social media (Bani & Dewi, 2021).

Some irresponsible people often misuse technological advances that occur to spread news and information that can threaten the sovereignty of the Indonesian nation. Some of this information is hoax news, the spread of some ideology that is not in harmony with the national character, inappropriate images and advertisements, bullying cases, and others (Rujiani, 2019).

That is a problem and also a warning for us. The advancement of technology with ease of information if a wise attitude in studying it does not accompany it will become a boomerang for technology users. Social media can also change individuals who initially like to socialize to become more aloof and shift social values. It can damage the morale of the younger generation (Bani & Dewi, 2021). Based on the description above, the author wishes to discuss why Pancasila can protect the millennial generation intensely. This literature study will focus on how the existence of Pancasila can defend the nation's next-generation (Humaidi, 2019)(Putri & Dewi, 2021).

II. METHODS

5 The method used in compiling this article is literature review. Literature review is a process that includes identification of work results, whether published or not, from various secondary data sources. Then evaluate the results of the work concerning

the problem, and finally document the results (Sekaran & Bougie, 2010). In this article, literature review is in the form of a summary of 10 articles with the following mechanism:

Study Protocol

The writing of this article is guided by the atlas.ti. This application is a computer program that is used mostly, but not exclusively, in qualitative research or qualitative data analysis so that it will be easier for the author to find problems according to the theme.

Article Search Strategy

Those 10 articles were obtained by searching three online journal/article databases, namely Google Scholar, Microsoft Academic, and Directory of Open Access Journal (DOAJ). The keywords taken are under the theme in the article, namely the existence of Pancasila, the millennial generation, technology.

Inclusion Criteria

The inclusion criteria of this article are as follows: it is a journal about Pancasila values and the millennial generation according to the theme, published in 2019 to 2021, written in both Indonesian and English, access to the full text of the article.

Exclusion Criteria

The exclusion criteria for this article are as follows: it is a journal that is not about Pancasila values and the millennial generation, published under 2019, written in languages other than Indonesian and

English, does not have access to the full text of the article.

III. RESULTS

The results of the literature review obtained from 10 articles based on inclusion criteria and obtained from 3 journal/article databases, namely Google Scholar, Microsoft Academic, and Directory of Open Access (DOAJ), obtained the following results:

1. Article with the title "Pancasila According to the Young Generation." This article is motivated by Millennial Generation's perspective witnessing the development of Pancasila and the role of generations which is very important for our nation. It is because, in this era, globalization will make every nation and country, especially Indonesia must be prepared to face various negative impacts. Some of them is the negative impacts brought about by globalization and modernization and about generations millennial the living in the middle era development so that they live as if without any limitations.

Another risk is cases that mostly happened until it is considered commonplace, such as criminal acts, harassment, torture, murder, and the number of corruption cases committed by several high-ranking state officials where the sanctions gave was lighter than they should have been. Suppose their

knowledge of Pancasila does not fortify the younger generation. That will disturb our nation's safety and integrity because it is a shared responsibility and must be realized together, especially for the next generation.

Not only that, the next generation of the nation need to be involved in various activities, such as: take an active role in student organizations, participate in multiple competitions that can make our nation proud, participate in the democratic party, scored various achievements, called for conflict resolution based on values and values organization and participate in conservation activities and cultivating the noble values of Pancasila in the community, both in the regional and national scope which aims to bring Indonesia to a better direction than before. In other words, the central role of the generation These millennials are agents of change who, with their presence and innovation, can bring

Indonesia to be a better country in the future (Wulandari, 2021).

2. Article title "The Importance of Citizenship Education as well as its Application and Relevance in Life in the Millennial Generation of Technology Era." This article states that the millennial generation is a generation that is very vulnerable to being affected by negative things if they do not receive good and strong moral, religious and civic education. The millennial generation is the era of a generation that grew up in modern times where many conveniences are provided, one of which is social media. The presence of social media has resulted in very drastic changes to the millennial generation, especially in their social life.

The existence of social media brings changes to the beliefs, values, and attitudes of the millennial generation. Today's young age is very easy to trust information whose validity is unclear if they cannot distinguish between real and fake news. - Violence case, harassment, murder, lack of family resilience, corruption and even drugs.
- Leaving their cultural character as a result of behaving by the trend

This article focuses on student service activities in Sintang Regency to regenerate the nation's character, which has faded due to the influence of globalization. Globalization brings many negative impacts that will influence the younger generation's morality, such as the erosion of the sense of love for the homeland and nationalism of the younger generation, the decline in the sense of solidarity and solidarity. So the existence of Pancasila is needed because Pancasila's ideology contains noble values that become the benchmark for the moral attitudes and behavior of the Indonesian nation to create a new generation who has the character of Pancasila and adheres to the norms of society.

The fundamental values of Pancasila must continue to be preserved by every young generation. The application of these Pancasila values can be implemented through student service activities to strengthen national commitment, which in these activities is considered capable of instilling Pancasila values in the millennial generation (Mardawani, 2019).

Pancasila education needs to be taught to the community, especially the younger generation who live in this era. If we are not being able to apply the values that are contained in Pancasila in everyday life as a result of being mixed with instantaneous external culture, the social spirit between one another will be depleted shortly, replaced by the presence of new technology which causes them to be more concerned with life in cyberspace.

As the basis of the state, Pancasila implies that the values contained in it are the guidelines for the Indonesian people. So that Pancasila education should be taught at the school and college level because the millennial generation, as the nation's future, should apply the values in Pancasila in everyday life, is in line with the character and norms of Pancasila (Anggraini et al., 2020).

The attitude of tolerance inherent in the heart and soul will minimize bullying (Rujiani, 2019).

9. Article title "The Role of Citizenship Education for Millennial Generation

Globalization will harm Indonesian citizens if it is not fortified with Pancasila, such as it can make the Indonesian people believe that liberalism can bring progress and prosperity, and the view of the younger generation towards the nation's ideology changes is one of the factors of the reduced sense of Nationalism and Pancasila in them.

Globalization also has an impact on the Indonesian people, especially the millennial generation in the economic field. There are too many millennial generations that imitate the trend in the fashion world where this trend is mainly against the nation's character to forget their identity as an Indonesian. 10. The article with the title "The Role of Pancasila Moral Values in Technological Advancement in the Millennium Era" discusses how technological progress influences the millennial generation. The existence of Pancasila, whose values are fading, also has an impact on the decline in the morality of the millennial generation. One way to restore the existence of Pancasila is through education, where education is one of the media that works for the morale of the next generation of the nation. Through formal education, Pancasila's moral-based learning model is one solution to improve the morality of the nation's children in the midst of the increasing moral crisis as a result of technological advances. In addition to producing excellent and superior individuals, this learning model must also prepare citizens to face technological advances in the millennium era. So, education functions not only to provide knowledge but also to prepare the nation's children so that later they become citizens who cultivate values and morals and obey the law (Palinggi & Ridwany, 2020)

IV. DISCUSSION

With the phenomenon of digitalization and social media as a communication space at the same time, public interaction has become a significant need (Meynawati & Dewi, 2021). Social media is now filled with news about false information, provocations containing SARA, hate speech, insults, defamation, and anti-Pancasila attitudes that can impact discrimination and violence. The phenomenon of digitization makes information circulate so quickly that much information whose credibility and the truth is not yet known is consumed by the public (Budiana & Warta, 2019). In society, post ideology like today prefers to hang out in shopping centers (malls), busy playing devices, gossip, overspending (hedonism), and others. Various platforms are provided to communicate via social media, changing the way millennials communicate. Until more Lots individual that has individuality

because they are busy with their respective smartphones (Dwi Putro, 2019).

The existence of Pancasila is needed to minimize these conditions, where the millennial generation who has a Pancasila character will avoid the negative impact of technological advances due to the Industrial revolution. The ideology of Pancasila contains noble values that become the benchmark for the moral attitudes and behavior of the Indonesian nation (Mardawani, 2019). If these values disappear, citizens, especially the millennial generation, will be directly exposed to technological advances' negative impacts. The existence of Pancasila can be re-emerged with several actions.

We can cultivate nationalism by actively participating in the commemoration of the youth oath day, independence day, heroes day, and other national holidays, as well as playing an active role in the activities of the nation and state. Then embed Pancasila values through Pancasila and Citizenship Education so that the morals of the younger generation themselves are not eroded by time and technology. Next, implementing the values in Pancasila through student service activities. The practice of Pancasila values through Pancasila Education to form a Pancasila, nationalist, and patriotism. Planting and cultivating Pancasila-based character education to realize the unity and integrity of the Indonesian state and applying the Pancasila moral-based learning model through formal education.

One form of technological progress is the presence of social media. If used properly, this social media can be used in learning Pancasila for the millennial generation, especially on university scope.
